Our desire is to see **His perfect Kingdom come** in our midst as our lives come into **obedience** to Him as the King of both heaven and earth, trusting that He will **provide all we need**, including food, shelter, love, wisdom, guidance, healing, **forgiveness** for ourselves and others, **protection** from temptation, and **deliverance** from the wiles of the enemy of our souls. **How much better can Good News get?**
